On July 18, 2018, the horses "Charge A Bunch" and "Carson Valley" were involved in a training accident at Del Mar Race Track which resulted in the death of both horses. Pursuant to the association's obligation under Rule 1846.5, a transportation company was notified of the fatalities and requested to respond to the track to transport the horses. The transporter, Stiles Animal Removal, Inc., responded to the race track and removed the horses. Pursuant to a contractual agreement between Del Mar Thoroughbred Club and Stiles, as well as the requirements set forth in Rule 1846.5, the horses were to be transported to the UC Davis California Animal Health and Safety Laboratory in San Bernardino (CAHS).  Instead, the horses were transported to the El Sobrante Landfill. During the investigation, it was discovered
